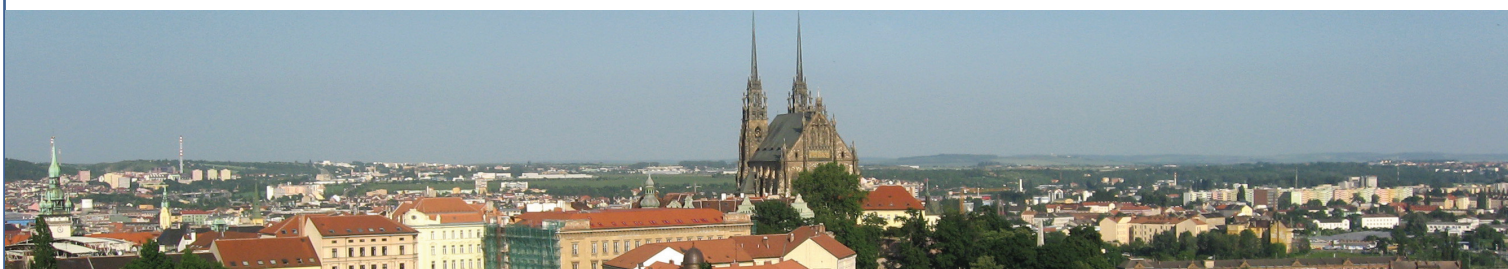

Czech Republic

Czech Republic lies in the middle of Europe. It is divided into three parts: Bohemia, Moravia and Silesia. It has about 10,2 million inhabitants. Despite the fact that the Czech Republic is a member of European Union, the currency is Czech Crown (1 = 25,5 CZK). The capital city is Prague.

History of the area is very long and rich. Czechoslovakia was founded as an independent state in 1918. In 1993 Czechoslovakia was divided into two independent states: Slovak Republic and Czech Republic.



Brno

Brno is the second largest city in the Czech Republic. It was founded in 1243 although the area had been settled since the 5th century. It is the metropolis of Moravia, historical and cultural city. Brno has nearly 370 000 inhabitants.

City of Brno is seat of many institutions, universities and theatres. It is well-known for its famous trade fairs and Grand Prix of road motorcycles.

City baseball stadium

New baseball stadium on Sokolova street was opened in 2007. Thanks to the new stadium new era for AVG Draci Brno club and generally for baseball in Brno started. The stadium belongs to the most modern stadiums in Europe.

There are 3 batting cages (2 of them are covered), 4 bullpens (2 on home side, 2 on visitor side), 3 changing rooms and massage room. Important part of the stadium is also a restaurant "Fifth base" from which you can watch the games. Within the area of the stadium there is also a playground for kids.
